

Illinois ENPC Instructor Course

The Illinois ENA Pediatric committee will host an ENPC instructor course as a pre-session to the 2009 ENA Spring Symposium. This instructor course is scheduled on April 2, 2009 at the Oakbrook Doubletree Hotel. Please contact Mary (MO) Otting regarding this course as registration will be limited. **Pretesting will occur on April 1st, 2009 in the evening and needs to be prescheduled with MO.**

Instructor Course admission requirements are:

1. A letter from an ENPC provider **course director** that will assist in obtaining the monitoring necessary for completion of instructor candidate requirements.
2. **Current** ENPC provider card.
3. The letter of recommendation received from the ENPC Provider course director indicating instructor potential. This would be from the location where you took your ENPC course (preferred)
4. Precourse Test Requirements: (April 1st, 2009)
 - A Achievement of at least **90%** on the provider multiple-choice exam.
 - B Achievement of at least **85%** of total points in each provider skill station.

All applications are due no later than Feb 25th, 2009

Applications will be reviewed and candidates notified of their acceptance into the course by March 8th, 2009. Payment is **due upon acceptance and must be completed prior to the course pretesting date.**

Again as was done last year, we will offer the pretesting for the class on Wed April 1st from 6p-9p. This will need to be prescheduled with MO.
